Home/School Agreement
Nursery

Children achieve more when home and school work together. This home/school agreement sets out the responsibilities of the school and what the school expects of its pupils.

The school will:-

- Provide your child with a balanced curriculum, which meets and strives to exceed Government requirements.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school and know more about its work.
- Keep you informed of your child's progress through an opening evening, an annual general report and lots of opportunities for discussion informally throughout the year. We will let you know about any concerns, which affect their progress or behaviour.
- Support and advise on any Special Educational Needs that your child may have.
- Provide suggestions for activities you can do at home. Send home a book for sharing once a week.
- Advise you about school activities through letters home and notices on windows around the school, and the P.T.A. notice board in the infant and junior playgrounds.
- Provide a safe, caring environment for your child.

As a parent or Carer I will try to:-

be a partner in my child's education by supporting his/her learning at home by

- Sharing books with my child and encouraging them by showing an interest in nursery activities.
- Attending meetings, which concern him/her.
- Ensuring my child attends on time every school day. I will let the school know on the first day they are absent due to illness.
- Supporting the school's behaviour policy. (Copies available from the school office)
- Informing the school about any problems, which might affect my child's behaviour or work.
- Ensuring that my child wears suitable clothing for nursery life, including sensible shoes and a suitable coat on rainy days.

As a pupil I will try:-

- To enjoy going to nursery.
- Look after my coats and jumpers and take care of nursery toys
- Be kind to other children.
- Share toys with other children.
- Sit still and listen in my group (cat or dog)
