Children achieve more when home and school work together. This home/school agreement sets out the responsibilities of the school and what the school expects of its pupils.

The school will:-

- Provide your child with a balanced curriculum, which meets and strives to exceed Government requirements.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school and know more about its work.
- Keep you informed of your child's progress through regular formal meetings once a term, an annual general report and opportunities for discussion informally throughout the year. We will let you know about any concerns, which affect their work or behaviour.
- Support and advise on any Special Educational Needs that your child may have.
- Provide tasks to be completed at home taking into account your child's age and abilities.
- Advise you about school activities through letters home and notices on windows around the school, and the P.T.A. notice board in the infant and junior playgrounds.
- Provide a safe, caring environment for your child.

As a parent or Carer I will try to:-

be a partner in my child's education by supporting his/her learning at home by

- Encouraging the completion of tasks sent home e.g. learning tables, spellings, key facts and reading.
- Attending meetings, which concern him/her.
- Ensuring my child attends on time every school day. I will let the school know on the first day they are absent due to illness.
- Supporting the school's behaviour policy. (Copies available from the school office)
- Ensuring that my child wears school uniform, and has P.E. kit and swimming kit.
- Informing the school about any problems, which might affect my child's behaviour or work.

As a pupil I will try:-

- To work hard and let others work hard.
- To not say or do things which hurt others.
- Look after my property and care for school equipment, buildings and grounds.
- To treat others and their property with respect.
