

## MULTIPLICATION TABLES CHECK - SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD AT HOME

Ensure your child practises his/her times tables every day at home for at least 10 minutes. It is better to spend time learning a particular times table (for instance, the 7 times table) before moving on to a different one.

Children need to know their times tables out of sequence. Keep this in mind when you test them at home.

Remind your children about the commutative law: the product (total) of  $5 \times 6$  is the same as  $6 \times 5$ . This can help them develop mental agility when answering questions.
