I am writing to introduce to you **Weduc – our new communications tool to keep you informed about all matters relating to your child learning and life at school.**

Improving how we communicate has been something we have been looking at for a long time based on feedback we have received from parents and carers alike. In addition to this, we as a school have experienced parents and carers requesting information that had been sent as letters or the school's journal. With the advance of technology, and with almost everyone having a smartphone, it makes sense to move to an easier, electronic way of communication. There will still be a place for paper copies, but this will be on request.

With Weduc, you can now experience the following improvements: -

- ✓ You will be able to receive letters, reminders and updates whilst 'on the go' by downloading the app either to your mobile phone or tablet. You can also access Weduc via your web browser.
- ✓ You will receive targeted communication *only relevant* to your child and their life at school. No more reading through unnecessary or irrelevant communication!
- ✓ You will get notifications directly to your phone or tablet. This means no more missed messages about important school events.
