Swimming	Changing Rooms	Cross contamination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divide the Rear of the pool for Boys changing using dividers • Girls to use both changing room with curtains • Spot markers to be used for identifying changing spaces 	Swimming Lead
	Equipment	Cross contamination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 bench and 1 chair to remain pool side. Remaining benches to be used for additional changing room. • Equipment to be dunked / washed in chlorinated water after each activity. • Large box filled with chlorinated water to be pool side. • Staff hand highline promoted. 	Entrance / Exit points	Cross contamination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If needed a one way system of access to the pool will be introduced. • Staggered entrance and exit to the pool. 	Swimming Lead SLT
	Waiting times	Cross contamination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children to register and enter the pool straight away with social distancing. • After the swimming lesson children to line up outside the swimming pool along the length of the building, supervised by LSA. 	Swimming Lead
	Pool cleaning	Cross contamination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boxes cleaned after each lesson (spray and cloth / wipes) • Changing rooms – pegs, benches walls will be sprayed and wiped down after each lesson. • Pool ladder to be cleaned after each lesson • Floor to be scrubbed and washed with chlorinated water. • Pool drainage to be checked before each lesson. Physical Education	Lesson	Lack of social distancing / contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lessons to take place outdoors in Autumn term • Teachers to use the grid to space out children. • Children to have an allocated box to work in small groups with their own set of equipment. • Equipment should not be moved between groups. • KS1 playground teacher will need to mark out boxes with cones for children to use.
