Collecting children after school in very wet weather

Dear Parents and Carers,

Heading further into Autumn, we can expect the weather to become colder with spells of rain. Generally, we seldom have very heavy rain that affects the way children are dismissed to you at the end of the day. However, there may be occasions when it is raining heavily at dismissal times. To keep the children as dry and safe as possible, we are going to dismiss classes from the following points in very wet weather. Please note, there are no changes to the dismissal procedure for some classes:

Classes	Collection point in very wet weather
ARP, Nursery, Reception, Yr2 and 6G	No change. The teacher will hand your child to you from their class.
1A	The teacher will hand your child to you at the door leading to the Reception playground.
1B	The teacher will hand your child to you at the blue doors next to the Yr1 toilet. This is where the children normally come into the building in the morning.
1S	The teacher will hand your child to you at the blue doors next to the Reception toilet.
3H, 4J and 5L	The teacher will hand your child to you from their classroom.
3F and 3M	The teacher will hand your child to you at the entrance to the tunnel. This is where the children normally come into the building in the morning.
4K and 4V	The teacher will hand your child to you at the door to the Juniors' Hall that leads to the Juniors' playground.
5T	The teacher will hand your child to you from class 2R which is downstairs in the Cube
5U	The teacher will hand your child to you from class 2W which is downstairs in the Cube
6I and 6P	The teacher will hand your child to you at the door to the library.

If you are unsure of the exact location, please ask your child's teacher to show it to you. We will send you a text message on the afternoon when we need to use these procedures.

The safety of your children is our main priority. We appreciate your understanding and patience as the dismissal will take longer than usual in wet weather.
