Science, art and D&T

- Draw and label a plane or tank from WW2
 - Design a WW2 themed game
- Make do and mend; create a World War II toy using only recycled materials
 - Mark a WW2 artefact e.g. a medal or a ration book
 - Make a drawing, painting or collage of a WW2 scene
- Air raid siren Investigation - Does a cone-shape make sounds louder? Make cones from different materials and investigate.

Music

- Write a song to boost morale during WW2
- Learn a wartime song and perform to your friends or family
- Find out 5 pieces that Glenn Miller wrote and look at the instruments he wrote them for.

Computing

- Research what the blackout was and the effect it had on people. What would you have invented to combat this problem?
 - Research the life of Anne Frank
- Research and create a fact file on key events e.g. battle of Britain, the Blitz, VE day or D-Day
