Dear Parents/Carers.

We hope you and your children have had an easy transition into their new classes and that you have all had a stress-free first half term!

During the second half of the Autumn term, we will have many focus areas in English and Maths. In Maths we will be focusing on knowledge of fractions and position and direction. In English we will be reading a non-fiction book called 'Suffragette the Battle for Equality' and our writing foci will be: newspaper articles, biographies and explanation texts.
