
Make a treasure map for a family member and hide something special around your house. Ask them to follow the map to find the treasure. Take turns hiding and finding items around your house.

Use your phonics skills to help your grown-up to make a shopping list. While shopping tick off the items you've put in your trolley.



Ask a grown-up to write a simple sentence, such as I can see the dog. 'Copy the sentence. Now write it again but change the end word. 'I can see...
