Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the Spring term. We hope you had a restful half term holiday and were able to spend time with your loved ones. Over the next half term, we will be learning the following:

In English, we will be reading, completing drama activities and writing tasks based on two books: Fantastically great women who changed the world and Herstory. Based on our focus books, we will be writing a newspaper report, learning how to take notes and writing a biography based on a historical figure. In Reading, we will develop our retrieval, summarising and comparison skills.

In Maths, we will be focusing on fractions: we will learn how to add, subtract and find fractions of different quantities. Later, we will learn about decimals, where we will focus on using the place value grid to identify the value of digits in decimal numbers. Finally, we will learn about money, where we will identify the different denominations, adding, subtracting and comparing money. We will also continue focusing on the $2,5,10,3,4,6,7,8$ and 9 times tables.

Our humanities focus this half-term will be History. We will be focusing on the unit called Made in Dagenham. This unit will give the children the opportunity to explore the various historical events and information linked to our local area, which is Dagenham.

We will also be studying Sports in French, (Vive le sport). In DT, we will be learning about seasonal foods, where the children will explore different kinds of foods and the seasons, they are produced in. in PSHE, we will concentrate on Physical Health. In RE, we will focus on Christianity and learn about the importance of Easter to Christians. In Music, we will continue with our music unit on recorders.
