Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the Summer Term. We are now into the last part of your child's time in Year Three. It has been a pleasure to see the children develop throughout the year in their maturity both socially and academically.

During English lessons we will be reading stories about a mystery that needs solving. The children will be writing character descriptions and then their own version of a mystery story. The book we will be reading is *Ottoline and the Yellow Cat*. During reading lessons, we will continue our work around fiction, paying particular attention to summarising and inference skills.

In Maths, we will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of fractions including counting in tenths, tenths as a decimal and introducing equivalent fractions. The children will also be working on time- both analogue and digital time. We will encourage the children to work on both digital and analogue. We will be consolidating our knowledge of the 2,3,4,5,6,8 and 10 times tables.

The children will be comparing Rome and London in our Geography lessons, looking at the human and physical aspects of the two cities. For Design and Technology we will be making photo frames using a Rome theme. We will be continuing our work in Science around plants, comparing living conditions and what soil is the best for plants to grow in.
