



## Nursery Summer Term 2



<b>Communication and Language</b>	This half term we will talk about the setting, characters and the structure of A story with confidence. We will be able to answer questions and share opinions using relevant vocabulary and use the past tense correctly. We will continue to listen to different nursery rhymes and join in singing words confidently and clearly.
<b>Physical Development</b>	We will develop our gross and fine motor skills by forming letters from our name outside and inside on different textures and with different mark making tools. In the garden we will practise aiming games such as football and skittles. We will develop our coordination and practise catching a ball. We will take part in group games, encouraging each other to take turns. We will learn to move in a range of ways and how to safely avoid obstacles.
<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>	In preparation for moving to Reception next year we will do transition activities such as visiting the dining hall and outdoor areas. We will visit the Reception classrooms and talk about all the lovely activities in Reception. We will also continue to gain enough confidence to talk to all adults and our peers.
<b>Literacy</b>	In Literacy we will try to write some letters and link them to the sound they make. We will play phonics games and sort objects according to their initial sound. We will share write sentences with our teachers and count the words.
<b>Mathematics</b>	This term in maths we will continue to practise recognising and sequencing numbers to 10. We will continue to revisit the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
<b>Understanding the World</b>	We will be learning about sea animals and make comparisons and talk about similarities and differences between them. We will learn about different types also think of our own questions to discover more. We will talk about significant events in our life and investigate floating and sinking materials.
<b>Expressive Arts and Design</b>	In EAD we will create sea animals and explore the natural materials found on a beach. We will be celebrating Father's Day and the children will make a card for their dad/someone special. We will listen to music and create movements to the different beats. We also look forward to creating invitations for our end of year celebration.
