Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a wonderful half-term break and are ready to enjoy the summer sunshine and all the lovely activities we have planned for the last part of the academic year.

Our topic for Summer 2 is Superheroes. As usual, we will focus on delivering this topic through English, Maths, Science, and Humanities including RE and PSHE, as well as the more creative areas such as Art, Music, and Drama. In English, we will introduce new storybooks related to our topic. We will describe and create story characters, explore the dialogue between characters, work on sentence construction, and explore the comic strip writing style. In Maths, we will continue to focus on learning place value and adding, subtracting, and multiplying. We will also learn about different ways to present data and sort shapes using various grouping methods.

The children will continue to have swimming lessons during Summer Term 2 on a Friday. Please ensure your child has a swimming kit on that day. This should include swimming trunks/costumes, a towel, and a swimming hat. We will also continue our PE lessons on a Thursday afternoon and would like the children to get changed into their kits as part of their independence and life skills learning. We are going to be practising our athletic skills, such as running, jumping, and throwing, as we are going to be involved in Sports Day this year. We will continue to focus on self-care this term, particularly thinking about exercise and how this helps to keep our bodies and minds healthy. We are also going to continue exploring how to keep our teeth healthy. To support this, we would appreciate it if you could send in a toothbrush for your child to use and keep in school. If there is a specific toothpaste they will only use, please provide a tube of this. Please complete the attached form if you permit us to help guide your child to clean their teeth during these sessions.
